



### Notox particulate filter approved in California

Notox' partner in the U.S., Environmental Solutions Worldwide (ESW), announced that it's wholly owned subsidiary ESW Canada Inc. (ESWC) received notification from the California Air Resources Board (CARB) that the Company's ThermaCat™ Active Level III Plus catalyst system has been verified effective April 28, 2009 for a wide variety of 1996 to 2009 diesel powered off-road mobile applications.

The ThermaCat™ system is also the first verified Level III Plus device for use on both tracked (example: Dozer, Excavator) and rubber tire (example: Loader, Grader) equipment powered by a wide variety of medium/heavy-duty diesel off-road engines. The ThermaCat™, as verified, proved capable of reducing diesel Particulate Matter (PM), Carbon Monoxide (CO) and Hydro Carbon (HC) in excess of 85% while meeting the nationwide stringent nitrogen dioxide (NO2) limitations. This new NO2 limit, which came into effect on January 1, 2009, requires that all verified diesel emission retrofit technologies sold and installed in North America must not increase NO2 emissions by more than 20%.

On July 6, 2007 CARB adopted a pioneering regulation aimed at reducing toxic and cancer-causing diesel emissions from the state's estimated 180,000 "off-road" vehicles used in construction, mining, airport ground support and other industries. This new regulation as reported outlines a potential \$3.5 billion retrofit market over its lifetime. With this approval, ESW and hereby Notox have gained access to the off-road retrofit market in California. For Notox this represents a milestone, as the American market is viewed as being an important growth market for retrofit in the coming years.

As stated in SBS' annual report for 2008, Notox expects a significant increase in revenue from the American retrofit market already in the second half year of 2009, as a number of Notox' customers have placed conditional orders that will be realised as soon as the CARB approval is in place.

As obtaining of the CARB approval forms part of the preconditions for the expected revenue growth in Notox, this does not give rise to alterations of Notox' or SBS' expectations for revenue or earnings for the 2009 financial year.
